- If you are pregnant or breastfeeding, or exploring your fertility, please do not handle medical products

dispensed for animals without suitable protection (e.g. gloves and/or a face mask).

- Users should consider the risk of medicines before allowing any form of exposure to occur.

Safe Handling of the Medicine Provided

- When handling liquids or ointments, disposable gloves should be worn. These may be available from the person dispensing the product.
- Wash hands after handling any medication.
- Avoid inhalation of the product, particularly if medication is divided, crushed or presented as a powder. Use of protective masks should be considered.
- Consider the use of protective eyewear to protect against accidental eye exposure when using and handling injections or potentially toxic solutions.
- If accidental eye contact occurs with any medication, flush gently with running water for 15 minutes and seek medical advice immediately should any irritation persists.
